## DECOREX AND WEST LONDON

An essential destination for interior designers, Decorex has lined up some big names for its thirty-fifth year, and Vivienne Westwood has been given free rein to design the foyer. The featured seminar speakers will include Min Hogg, Ben Pentreath, Angus Gibson, Kate Burnett and David Myers. Nearby at Earls Court, **100% Design** has been given a revamp under its new owners and new director, William Knight. The space will be divided into four, clear main sections: Eco Design and Build, Interiors, Kitchens and Bathrooms, and Office.
